1. Summary Information	
Academic Year: 2017-18	Total Sports Premium Budget: £19,690
2. What is Sports Premium Funding?	
<p>In 2013 the government announced spending of £150 million per year to be used in schools throughout the UK, specifically to improve the provision of physical education and sport in primary schools. Schools are free to spend the funding in whatever area of PE and sport that they feel needs to be improved upon. Examples can range from buying in coaches to purchasing new equipment. *The Government has recently announced that for 2017-18 the budget will be increased. With this change, we estimate our budget for the year to be £19,690. This Strategy Statement has been written to this figure, with the money being spent as and when it is received. We will sustain this provision by applying the CPD that has been given to all staff by specialist coaches. Furthermore, the PE lead will be able to deliver all PE sessions and Forest School sessions following the level 5 training and the Forest School training. The upgrade of the outdoor area will ensure improved active lunchtimes and playtimes.</p>	
3. Physical Education and Sport at Oulton First School	
<p>At Oulton First School we will use the money effectively in order to implement a PE programme which will ensure that all pupils leaving our school are physically literate and have the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and a lifelong love of physical activity and sport. All pupils at Oulton First School take part in two structured PE lessons per week, both are delivered by a specialist PE teacher which enables us to deliver high quality PE following the National Curriculum.</p> <p>This year we plan to use the additional funding to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Engage all our pupils in regular physical activity, kick-starting healthy active lifestyles</li><li>• Provide a broader range of sports and activities to all our pupils all year round, led by qualified PE coaches within and outside of the curriculum</li><li>• Educate the children in how to manage their fitness and wellbeing</li><li>• Continue to increase the opportunities for pupils to participate in competitive sport</li><li>• Provide CPD for our teachers</li></ul>	
<p>After careful consideration by the Governing Body it was decided that the money is to be used as outlined below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Audit and purchase new equipment where needed</li><li>• Pay for affiliation, entry fees and certificate.</li><li>• Pay for qualified specialist PE coach to work alongside staff to upskill staff and provide CPD and be managed by the PE specialist</li><li>• Pay for a qualified dance coach to work alongside staff to upskill staff</li><li>• Fund our PE lead to achieve the Level 5 PE Qualification</li><li>• Fund training for any staff in PE including network meetings and conferences.</li><li>• Develop outdoor facilities, by upgrading play ground- to include markings for games, improving muddy area with alternative surface</li><li>• Fund level 3 Forest School Training for PE lead</li></ul>
