Personal, Social & Emotional Development	Our topic this half term is 'Me and My School.' This week we will be continuing our own 'My School' booklet to keep in class.
*Communication & Language *Literacy	This week we will be learning about the nursery 'Wee Willie Winkee.' We will be making comparisons to the past and present.
*Maths	This week Reception will continue their learning all about numbers 1, 2 and 3. We will be learning about the Ten Town character Thelma Three. We will also be learning about using positional language, e.g. on, off, under, behind. Ladybirds will continue their learning about patterns this week.
* Understanding the World	This week we will be learning about growing up. We will be learning about babies, looking after our bodies and being healthy, and all the steps of growing to elderly age.
*Physical Development	This half term we will be learning new skills, such as finding a space, spatial awareness when playing games and running around, ball skills, moving around in different ways and much more!
*Expressive Arts & Design	This week we will be thinking about the sense of touch. We will be thinking about what we do with our hands and feet and will be singing some action songs together.
*Religious Education	This week in RE the children will be thinking about what precious means. God is precious to us and we will be reading the story of 'The Precious Pearl.'
