**Autumn 1, Week 5 - Week Beginning: 27.09.2021**

Personal, Social & Emotional Development	Our topic this half term is 'Me and My School.' This week we will be completing a checklist of different areas around the school, e.g. office, toilets, photocopier, etc.
*Communication & Language *Literacy	This week we will be reading the story 'My Family, Your Family.' We will be looking at our family photographs and talking about who is in our family. The children will be making pictures and labelling them.
*Maths	This week Reception will be learning about patterns. We will be learning about repeating patterns, e.g. making fruit pattern skewers.  Ladybirds will begin their learning about sorting, e.g. sorting socks, sorting objects by size, colour etc.
* Understanding the World	This week we will be learning about our sense of taste. We will be learning about our taste buds and having a little taste of some different foods, e.g., lemon, jam, salty crisps and dark chocolate.
*Physical Development	This half term we will be learning new skills, such as finding a space, spatial awareness when playing games and running around, ball skills, moving around in different ways and much more!
*Expressive Arts & Design	This week we will be using our mouths to sing nursery rhymes and songs in different ways.
*Religious Education	This week in RE the children will be recapping what we learnt about harvest last week, as well as thinking about foods that we can harvest. We will be having a taste of some foods that are harvested.
