**Curriculum over view:**

<b>English</b>	Pupils will research, plan and write a fact file on Samuel Pepys. They will also write about real events in the form of a diary entry, mime a scene and write a diary entry in the role of Samuel Pepys.
<b>Maths</b>	Y1: Subtraction within 10. Y2: Addition and subtraction.
<b>Science</b>	This half term we will focus on the theme Everyday Materials. This week pupils will make their Tudor house and evaluate it.
<b>Topic</b>	This week pupils will explore how people managed to live through the GFOL.
<b>Music</b>	This week we will be talking about pop songs. We will also listen, move and dance to the song 'We Talk To Animals'.
<b>RE</b>	Our theme this half term is Creation and we will explore the question - who created the world?
<b>Computing</b>	This week we will look at understanding and searching the internet.
<b>PSHE</b>	Our theme this half term is Me and My School.
