| <b>English</b>   | This week we will continue with the text <i>The Secret Sky Garden</i> . Pupils will be learning our Harvest poem.  |
| <b>Maths</b>     | Y1: Number Bonds<br>Y2: Place Value - numbers to 100.  |
| <b>Science</b>   | This half term we will focus on the theme <i>Everyday Materials</i> . This week pupils will continue to look at materials according to their properties. The children will be able to describe these through touch.  |
| <b>Topic</b>     | This term our topic is <i>The Great Fire of London</i> . This week pupils will explore why the GFOL burnt down so many houses.   |
| <b>Music</b>     | We will be using a new music resource this year called <i>Charanga</i> . This half term pupils will focus on the song <i>Hey You!</i> Which is written in an Old-School Hip Hop style for children to learn about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch and to learn how to rap and enjoy it in its original form. |
| <b>RE</b>        | Our theme this half term is <i>Creation</i> and we will explore the question - who created the world?  |
| <b>Computing</b> | Pupils will become familiar with the types of resources and icons available in the topics section on <i>Purple Mash</i> and will start to add a picture and text to a piece of work.   |
| <b>PSHE</b>      | Our theme this half term is <i>Me and My School</i> .  |
| <b>PE</b>        | During the autumn term the children will be doing multi-skills/fitness on a Tuesday and dance on a Thursday.   |
